Our Outcomes

- Served 121 attendees in 2022 (15% + from 2021)
- Reached participants in 10 states in the U.S., 90% of whom reside in Central Iowa
- Served 69% of households with income below \$60,000
- Served 79% of participants were females of color
- 100% of high school peer mentors sought higher education
- 75% of high school peer mentors study a STEM field
- Three high school students given the opportunity to earn 3 transferable college credits
- Corporate Partners donated 20 laptops to our students



Our Cost
